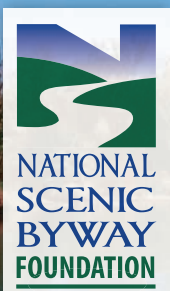

Who We Are:

The idea of creating a national not-for-profit organization to support scenic byways first surfaced at the 2001 National Scenic Byway Conference. At the 2003 conference, a group of interested individuals asked for and received additional input from conference attendees, then filed articles of incorporation and adopted bylaws.

The Foundation, now a 501(c)3, revised its strategic plan in 2010 and is actively engaged in assisting in the current and future development, management, preservation, and enhancement of byways through cooperation between units of government, the for-profit, and the not-for-profit sectors. The Foundation has established partnerships with organizations such as the American Recreation Coalition, in order to heighten awareness about the social and economic impact of America's Byways®.

The Foundation's Board of Directors represents various byway interests and is responsible for the overall policy and direction of the Foundation. We are working to shape a grassroots organization for our byways. Join us as we make the byways the best they can possibly be.
